- 1: Download the newest version Pangolin at <http://voipswitch-portal.com>
- 2: Run the Pangolin installer and follow the prompts in the install wizard.

## 2. Getting Ready

### Account Information

After choosing a VoIP service provider, you will need the following information:

- User name
- Password
- Authorization Name (usually same as Username)
- SIP Server and port
- User Domain

### System Requirements

Processor: Minimum: Intel Pentium III 1.0 GHz or equivalent

Optimal: Pentium 4® 2.0 GHz or equivalent

Memory: 512 MB

Hard Disk Space: 100 MB

OS: Windows2000, Windows XP, Windows Vista, Windows 7

Connection: IP network connection (broadband, LAN, wireless)

Sound Card: Full-duplex, 16-bit

## 3. Configuring Pangolin

If Pangolin is not already running, start it as you would any other program: Use the **Windows Start** menu or double-click the desktop icon . Pangolin login window appears.

## Setting up Accounts

After obtaining SIP account information from your VoIP service provider, you can set up Pangolin accounts.

1. Enter the user name, password, SIP server and port in the login window of Pangolin.
2. If want to use the Authorization name, stun server, user domain etc, then click the “Advanced” button.
3. Click the “login” to login into SIP server.
